### **How to Write a Book Report - Step by Step Guide**

Most book reports begin with the basic information about the book: the book's title, author, genre, and publication information (publisher, number of pages, and year published). The opening paragraph is also your opportunity to build interest by mentioning any unusual facts or circumstances about the writing of the book or noteworthy credentials of the author.

Write a little bit about why you liked or didn't like the book. Talk about how the book made you feel - happy, sad, excited. Would you tell your friends to read this book? When you're finished writing the report, read it over carefully to make sure everything is spelled correctly.

Read the book. It seems obvious, but too many students try to take a shortcut and simply read summaries or watch movies, but you often miss important details that can make or break your book report. Pay attention to detail. Keep an eye out for clues that the author has provided in the form of symbolism. These will indicate some important point that supports the overall theme.

### **Book Report: How To Write and Format A Book Report.**

Book reports generally follow a basic format that includes the following information: the title of the book and its year of publication the name of the author the genre (type or category) of the book (for example, biography, autobiography, or fiction)

### **Book Report: Definition, Guidelines, and Advice**

Book reports commonly describe what happens in a work; their focus is primarily on giving an account of the major plot, characters, thesis, and/or main idea of the work. Most often, book reports are a K-12 assignment and range from 250 to 500 words.

### **Book Report Instructions**

Make sure it has the appropriate number of pages and is an approved genre (science fiction, mystery, romance, historical fiction, etc.). Read the book thoroughly. You may want to highlight or mark pages that you find especially important or interesting.

At the middle and high-school level, most teachers typically expect three body paragraphs. With the intro and conclusion, that's the classic five-paragraph essay. If you're lucky, your teacher may only want one body paragraph for a book report. If you're unlucky, they may want more than three.
