Others have tried to deny that God is, in fact, Almighty, or omnipotent, and therefore when there is evil or suffering, he is just powerless to do anything about it. Atheists argue that God, if he is omnipotent, is powerful enough to stop moral atrocities, and if he is good, should be willing to stop moral atrocities.

The problem of evil, when stated like this, arises for believers if and only if they affirm that God is wholly good and all powerful at the same time. The problem can, however, be differently formulated. For if one believes in the existence of an omnipotent and benevolent God, the question can be asked; why didn't God create man wholly good?

If there is some moral standard the critic is basing their position on, then the problem of evil becomes an argument for not against the reality of God.
