If the transmission makes a rattling noise that is loudest in neutral, although it is always there, and the noise changes when it is put into gear, but shifts well, the input shaft bearing is bad. This is the shaft in the front of the transmission; the clutch is attached to it by the splines on the shaft.

Whining and Clunking. This may see fairly obvious, but those are often the symptoms we ignore the most. When your car starts making noises it shouldn't be making, it's time to get it checked out. You'll probably hear a humming or buzzing coming from your transmission.

As noted in a previous section, with a manual transmission, a common sign of trouble is a grinding sound or feeling when you shift into a new gear. If you fully engage the clutch, shift and then hear a grinding sound, you may have a worn clutch or you may just need to have it adjusted [source: AAMCO].
